**Dear Visitors,**

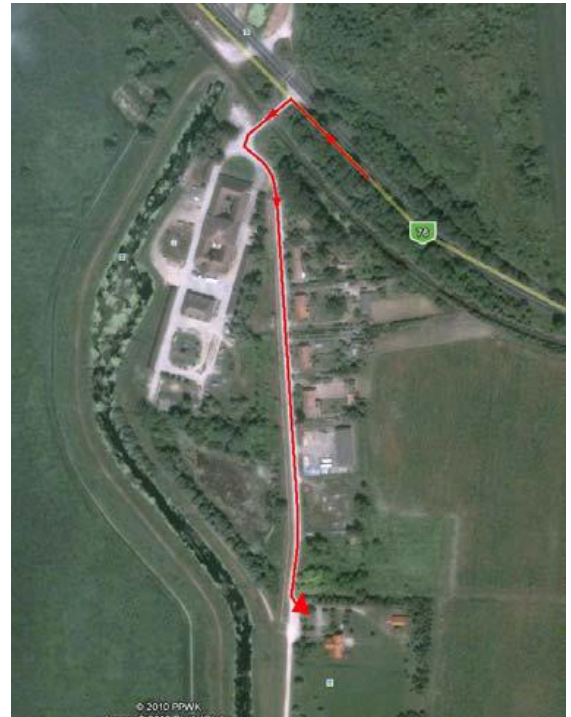
Kis-Balaton Nature Reserve is located close to Keszthely, southwest of Lake Balaton.

The **meeting place of the guided tours** is at Kis-Balaton Kutatóház (Kis-Balaton Research Centre), situated near Fenékpuszta.

**GPS: 46.700841,17.23867**

Take road 76 from Keszthely or Balatonszentgyörgy and drive towards Sármellék (to the west). Turn left where you see the flashing orange light and a small brown board saying 'Kis-Balaton Kutatóház'. After crossing the tracks which are no longer used, turn left again. Keep straight on and after 450 ms you will see the Research Centre on the left hand side of the dirt road.

There is no public transport between Keszthely and the Research Centre.



**The tour** takes 3 hours. It is done by the vehicle the visitors provide, predominantly a car, or a bus for larger groups. Please make sure that there is seating for the guide as well. We stop at certain points to walk or to watch birds. As a spectacular wetland habitat with exceptionally rich wildlife, Kis-Balaton offers lots to see. The terrain is flat, the dikes are covered with gravel.

**The fee** includes the 3-hour-long guidance in English in the strictly protected area. The tour includes a walk to Fekete István Memorial Site on Diás Island. (Visits to the Water Buffalo Reserve and to the Folk House in Vörs are not included. Participants of the guided tour get a discount from the full price ticket at these sites.)

Visitors take part in the guided tour at their own risk.
